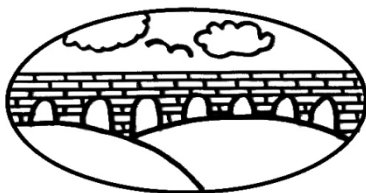

Members are reminded that under Members Code of Conduct they must register, within 28 Days, changes to their financial and other interests and notify the Monitoring Officer of any gifts and hospitality received deemed to be valued over £25.
